CITY COUNCIL ITEM **COMMUNICATION:** OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA 01-008 **SYNOPSIS** -**AGENDA:** An agreement has been proposed between the City of Des Moines and the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway (MLK) and Ingersoll Avenue Intersection **JANUARY 8, 2001** Improvement. This project would provide for the reconstruction of the intersection of MLK and Ingersoll Avenue, including the **SUBJECT:** upgrading of the traffic signals at the intersection. As a part of the reconstruction of the intersection, MLK will be extended to the **IOWA DEPARTMENT** south. Left turn lanes will be added along MLK with additional OF widening to create a seven-lane cross section. The left turn lanes will TRANSPORTATION be at least 150 feet long with four-foot wide raised medians with a standard six-inch curb. The design of this project is being done by AGREEMENT FOR THE M.L. KING, JR. Earth Tech, the consultant for the MLK project. PARKWAY AND INGERSOLL AVENUE The project will be let by IDOT as part of the MLK project from INTERSECTION Ingersoll Avenue to Center Street. The contract will be awarded through the City. **IMPROVEMENT FISCAL IMPACT -**TYPE: **RESOLUTION** The construction cost estimate is \$5,110,000 for this segment of **ORDINANCE** MLK. IDOT will provide a maximum of \$500,000 for construction RECEIVE/FILE costs related to the intersection improvement. The remaining cost will be funded by a combination of general obligation bonds, federal funds, and IDOT loans. Funding for the construction cost is shown in the current Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget, page **SUBMITTED BY:** STR-138, MLK - North/South Segment. FLOYD BENTZ, P.E. **BACKGROUND** -

On December 20, 1999, by Roll Call No. 99-3805, City Council authorized the City Manager to submit an application to IDOT for Traffic Safety Funding for this project as part of the overall funding package for the MLK project.

The Ingersoll Avenue intersection improvements will be completed with the overall project for MLK from the Ingersoll Avenue intersection to Center Street.
