Hubbell at East 33rd Street Intersection Improvement. This **JANUARY 8, 2001** project would provide for left turn lanes on Hubbell Avenue and new traffic signals at the intersection. **SUBJECT: IOWA DEPARTMENT FISCAL IMPACT -TRANSPORTATION** The total project cost, including right-of-way acquisition, is estimated to be \$740,000. The City will provide design and AGREEMENT FOR THE AVENUE F.M. construction inspection services and will acquire all necessary rightof-way. The City's cost is estimated to be \$240,000 with IDOT **HUBBELL AT EAST** funding limited to a maximum of \$500,000. IDOT has prepared an 33RD STREET INTERSECTION agreement for the proposed improvement. Funding for the project, which is estimated to be \$240,000, is included in the proposed **IMPROVEMENT** Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget - East 33rd Street and Hubbell Avenue intersection. Traffic Safety Funding for the Avenue F.M. Hubbell at East 33rd Street Intersection Improvement. The proposed project would provide for widening on the south side of Hubbell Avenue to provide left turn lanes on Hubbell Avenue at East 33rd Street and new traffic signals. Raised traffic medians will not be utilized. Part of the funding will be utilized to widen the bridge over Four Mile Creek which is also being reconstructed under a separate contract

this summer.

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
