IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT FOR THE PARK AVENUE AT S.W. 42ND STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT An agreement has been proposed between the City of Des Moines and the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for the Park Avenue at S.W. 42nd Street Intersection Improvement. The project consists of widening the north side of Park Avenue to provide for a westbound left turn, and the construction of an eastbound right turn lane, along with permanent traffic signals. The City will provide design and construction inspection services for the project. IDOT has prepared an agreement for the proposed improvement.

FISCAL IMPACT -

This agreement provides \$50,000 of Traffic Safety Funds for the proposed improvement. The total project cost is estimated to be \$300,000. The remaining \$250,000 has been submitted for funding in the proposed Capital Improvements Program budget.
