BACKGROUND -

On May 4, 1998, the Council approved the Gateway project and directed the City Manager to prepare various actions related to project implementation. On September 14, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-2909, the Council approved various actions related to Gateway project implementation, including the structure of the Gateway Steering Committee.

Since Council approval of the structure, the Des Moines Development Corporation merged with the Des Moines Chamber of Commerce and Choose Des Moines to form the Greater Des Moines Partnership. This reorganization necessitated clarification of GDMP's Gateway Steering Committee representatives. Upon examination of GDMP's representation on the Gateway Steering Committee, GDMP requested that an additional representative be added. In order to maintain balance, the City of Des Moines is also adding a representative.

Gateway Steering Committee membership will be reviewed on an annual basis to ensure the continued success of the project.
