SYNOPSIS -

The 2000 Iowa Legislature appropriated \$1 million for Fiscal Year (FY) 2001 Commercial Air Service Vertical Infrastructure Fund to the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for improvements at all ten commercial service airports within the state.

The program provides for one-half of the appropriated funds to be allocated equally between each of the commercial service airports and the remaining 40 percent and 10 percent of the funds to be divided based on enplanements and cargo activity, respectively. Enplanement data was based on the most current data available from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) which is calendar year 1999.

FISCAL IMPACT -

This distribution formula will provide the Des Moines International Airport \$344,993 for the current Fiscal Year, July 1, 2000 to June 30, 2001.

RECOMMENDATION -

Approval.

BACKGROUND -

On September 12, 2000, by Resolution No. A00-341, the Airport Board approved the application to IDOT for the Commercial Air Service Vertical Infrastructure Program for the following project:

- Airfield Maintenance Storage Building

On September 15, 2000, the Aviation Director submitted the application for funding under the Commercial Air Service Infrastructure Program for the project listed above.

On January 4, 2001, IDOT approved and forwarded the proposed grant agreement.

On February 6, 2001, the Airport Board recommended the City Council approve the grant agreement between the City and IDOT.
