**BACKGROUND -**

The Brody Middle School 28E Agreement was approved by the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board on January 25, 2000, and the Des Moines School Board on January 23, 2001.

The Agreement establishes a Steering Committee, which shall include ten members.

- Three persons designated by the School District.
- Three persons designated by the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board.
- Four members designated by the Southwestern Hills Neighborhood Association.

The Steering Committee shall have the following responsibilities:

- Meet regularly with Park and Recreation Department staff to establish a master plan for Brody Middle School.
- Prioritize the recommended improvements to assist in creating a schedule for said improvements.
- Present recommendations to appropriate boards, commissions, and community groups for approval.

Upon approval from the various Boards, Commissions, and the City Council, the School District and the City shall identify and develop a schedule for funding, construction, maintenance, and shared use of the improvements, as an addendum to the 28E Agreement.
