BACKGROUND -

On February 26, 2001, by approving the Park & Recreation Department's revised Fiscal Year (FY) 2001 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget, City Council granted authorization and funding to proceed with the completion of a redevelopment plan for Greenwood and Ashworth Parks. The completion of this plan for these two parks is identified as a goal in the Parklands document, which is a component of Des Moines' Comprehensive Plan. Recent citizen interest in some elements of the parks has caused this project to move to the forefront.

The consultant selection committee has reviewed proposals submitted by five consultants and unanimously recommends Brian Clark & Associates as the consultant for the project.

The Agreement for Professional Services calls for the consultant to collect input from the public and several organizations that have an interest in the redevelopment of the two parks. The consultant will

use this input in preparing a redevelopment plan. The proposed fee for these services is \$25,300.
