

CHIEF OF POLICE	The City Council approved the original "Youth at Risk" proposal and accepted the award from GASA on April 6, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-1032.
	The "Youth at Risk" program concept was developed to create a partnership between the Des Moines Police Department, Juvenile Court, and the State's Youthful Offender Program, to take enforcement action against adjudicated youth who taunt the criminal justice system through continued disobedience to court-ordered sanctions. This will be the fourth and final year for this program.
