ANDERSON necessary amendments to the Des Moines Municipal Code. CITY MANAGER On October 2, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-466, the City Council declared its intent to provide matching funds in the amount of \$10,000 subject to final approval of a grant submittal to the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for funding art projects at neighborhood gateways along the reconstructed I-235. Since the IDOT grant was not ultimately funded, the \$10,000 is now being

applied to the Iowa Community Grant Application.
