<b>RESOLUTION</b> ORDINANCE RECEIVE/FILE	In Fiscal Year (FY) 2000, the City received \$4,500 from this grant source. The grant application was not made for FY 2001. This grant will be applied toward FY 2002.
<b>SUBMITTED BY:</b>  DONALD M. TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	"Nitefall on the River" concert series is a ten-week series held at the Simon Estes Riverfront Amphitheater. This is the fifth year of the series. The series features a mix of music styles. "Nitefall on the River" provides quality family entertainment and employs Iowa artists when possible.  A combination of admission fees, sponsorship dollars, grant dollars, and City funds allow for quality and affordable access to the arts. The grant will be matched by an anticipated revenue of \$56,700 in admissions and \$10,000 in private contributions. The grant will reduce the City's fiscal impact.
