DONALD M. TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	On July 25, 2000, the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board received and filed a request from the Des Moines Disc Golf Club to develop a disc golf course at Ewing Park.
	On February 27, 2001, the Des Moines Park and Recreation Board recommended approval for the installation of an 18-hole disc golf course at Ewing Park.
	Park and Recreation Department staff and representatives from the Des Moines Disc Golf Club have made presentations to the Bloomfield/Allen Neighborhood Association and Parks Committee. Both groups have endorsed the project and support the installation of the course this spring.
	Through this process, citizens from the Bloomfield/Allen Neighborhood Association requested an asphalt parking lot to be installed at the south parking lot for better access to the lilacs and

southern portion of the park. This improvement is budgeted in this current Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget and will be built in conjunction with the course construction. Staff anticipates construction to begin this spring with a June 1st opening date.

This will be the second disc golf course built in Des Moines. The first was built in Grandview Park and has been very successful.
