UNDERWOOD ACTING HOUSING SERVICES DIRECTOR	Previously, the Drug Elimination Program grants were primarily budgeted to provide for two full-time coordinators, a volunteer tenant patrol, a learning center, and quarterly family events.  The resident survey conducted last year reflected that many of the elderly/disabled residents were concerned about security in the five manors. With the pending relocation of the Administrative Offices from Royal View Manor, residents have expressed concerns over additional security. Reallocation of Drug Elimination Program funds will provide for additional security.
	Revisions will allow for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· One full-time coordinator</li><li>· Security plates to be installed at South View Manor</li><li>· Continuation of a quarterly newsletter</li><li>· Continuation of the "Welcome Wagon" Program for families moving into public housing</li><li>· Execution of a contract for security guard services at Royal View</li></ul>

Manor and other manors when needed

Reallocation of the previous budget will fund operations to the maximum allowed by HUD.
