WILLIAM H. MOULDER CHIEF OF POLICE	Rock In Prevention is a program that trains high school students to work with elementary age children on drug prevention strategies. Representatives of the program are requesting the City sponsor a \$200,000 pass-through grant from the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy. This grant will enable Rock In Prevention to continue a drug prevention program that is currently operating in 15 Des Moines schools.  The Department of Justice funds the grant through the Byrne Program, which is named for a New York City Police Officer who was killed in a shoot-out. The program runs July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002 and requires the City be the sponsor.
