CITY ENGINEER	<b>BACKGROUND -</b>  A citizen request was forwarded from Council Member Hensley to the Traffic and Transportation Division, asking that a stop sign be installed on 57th Street at Kingman Avenue. This "T" intersection is currently uncontrolled. Staff has reviewed the conditions and recommends that a stop sign be installed on 57th Street at Kingman Avenue. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this change into effect.  <b>SEC. 114-2254. KINGMAN AVENUE.</b>  <u>Kingman Avenue, at Fifty-seventh Street, stop.</u>
