	In addition to the FAA AIP Grant funds for the Runway 5-23 and Taxiway 'P' construction southwest of existing Runway 13L-31R

project, reimbursements from the IANG will be \$1,132,382.58 for Divisions 4 and 5. The City has already received approval of Division 4 work in an amount of \$356,364, and the contract is structured to authorize Division 5 at a later date. The Airport received authority to issue Subordinate Airport Commercial Paper Revenue Notes, Series C, with a maximum aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time of not to exceed \$5,000,000 to pay for non-grant eligible elements of the project and for the 10 percent local matching share of the grant eligible elements of the project. This interim (five-year maximum) commercial paper is anticipated to be repaid from future airport revenue bonds as noted in Council Communication No. 00-344.

RECOMMENDATION -

(1) Approve execution and acceptance of a 90 percent federal share FAA grant for funding of the 2001 Phase 6 construction of the Runway 5 extension project; (2) Ratify and adopt all assurances, warranties, covenants and agreements required by project application and incorporated in grant offer; and (3) Direct Mayor to execute grant agreement, City Clerk to attest and Aviation attorney to certify to grant execution for a 90 percent federal share FAA grant in an amount of \$12,277,381 to the City of Des Moines as soon as the grant documents come from FAA.

BACKGROUND -

This grant was previously approved on March 12, 2001, but the documents were not released on the anticipated schedule. Therefore, grant acceptance must be reauthorized.
