<b>SUBMITTED BY:</b>  WILLIAM STOWE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR	On March 29, 2001, representatives of the Public Works Department, the City Manager's Office, and the Des Moines Water Works met with Ms. Kristi Lozier and Mr. Bill VanOrsdal of the Greenwood Historic Neighborhood to discuss neighborhood concerns about closing SW 31st Street. After learning that the Des Moines Water Works intends to convert the intersection of SW 31st Street and Edwards Avenue to a major entrance to the Park, neighborhood leadership was supportive of the Public Works initiated request to close SW 31st Street to motor vehicle traffic.
