This will be accomplished with the formation of a Youth Patrol, implementation of prevention curriculum, teen prevention programming, adult education and computer skills development, a case management and community leadership program, as well as the expansion of the existing services provided by the Oakridge Neighborhood and the surrounding community's youth and residents.<br><br>If grant funds are awarded by HUD, a July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003 grant period is anticipated. |

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
