	have proposed that as a condition for the use of the property, they will provide the following necessary services for the City at no cost:
	$\cdot$ Initial clean up and debris removal
	· Mowing and maintenance of all grassed areas
	· Trimming and maintaining of all shrubbery

 $\cdot$  Maintain and regularly police the property to prevent unauthorized use and activity except as authorized by the agreement

The value of these proposed services is estimated to be approximately \$2,300, exceeding the fair market lease value for the property.
