## **BACKGROUND** -

On December 2, 1996, by Roll Call Nos. 96-4021 and 96-4024, the City of Des Moines and Airport Commerce Park, L.C. entered into development agreements regarding the construction of certain improvements in Airport Commerce Park South and Airport Commerce Park West. The purpose of the agreements was to enable commercial and industrial development in these areas near the Des Moines International Airport.

In accordance with the development agreements, Airport Commerce Park, L.C. has constructed improvements in Airport Commerce Park South and Airport Commerce Park West. In November 16, 1998, by Roll Call Nos. 98-3571 and 98-3572 the City Council issued Certificates of Partial Completion for improvements within Phase 1 of the Airport Commerce Park South project, including improvements to Fleur Drive and improvements within Phase 1 of Airport Commerce Park West.

Since the issuance of these Certificates of Partial Completion, the developer, Airport Commerce Park, L.C., has continued to make improvements to these parks in conformance with their respective development agreements. The current requests reflect the improvements done to date in conformance with the development agreements.
