UNDERWOOD ACTING DIRECTOR	Housing Authority (DMMHA) has a client base of 345 elderly and/or disabled residents living in targeted units. Staff has observed
ACTING DIRECTOR	that sometimes services for these residents are not immediately
	available and require a period of waiting for assistance from other service providers.
	The DMMHA Helping Hands Program will assist elderly and
	disabled persons living in public housing to access services in urgent situations. Transportation, food, clothing, medical access,
	housekeeping services, and other basic needs will be met until long-
	term services can be arranged. A program coordinator will administer funds, work with service coordinators to identify residents
	in need of emergency assistance, and develop prevention-oriented
	workshops. Access to such services will improve self-sufficiency

among elderly and disabled public housing residents and in some cases avoid evictions.

This grant would pay for a half-time program coordinator for three years to administer the funds and arrange for classes and workshops to improve residents' physical and mental health, and for a gap fund which can be drawn on for emergencies.
