FLOYD BENTZ, PE CITY ENGINEER	This project involves installation of new automatic flashing light signals with gate arms, 12-inch LED lenses and prediction circuitry at the crossing. The Union Pacific Railroad Company will design, install, and maintain the signals. The City's only responsibility is to maintain advance warning signs and pavement markings and ensure clear view of the signals.
