	By Roll Call No. 01-916, on March 26, 2001, the City Council approved a Skywalk Agreement with Hubbell Realty Co. for a skywalk bridge across Walnut Street connecting the Hubbell Building and the Federal Home Loan Bank Building. A Skywalk Agreement has been negotiated with Federal Home Loan Bank, which will be executed with a property transfer to Federal Home Loan Bank for their proposed expansion located north of Walnut Street, east of 10th Street.
	Since William Anderson Architecture is the consultant working on the Hubbell Building and the Federal Home Loan Bank Building with their skywalk corridors, William Anderson Architecture was selected

as the consultant for Skywalk Bridge 9C-9D since many of the specifications will be the same, providing a more efficient design.

This skywalk bridge is one section of the skywalk system extension, which will provide a connection to the new Allied Building at 10th and Walnut Streets.
