WILLIAM MOULDER CHIEF OF POLICE	Federal legislation established a Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant Program. In Iowa, the program is administered by the State Criminal and Juvenile Justice Planning and Statistical Analysis Center. A portion of these funds are available to local governments for programs to reduce juvenile delinquency, improve the juvenile justice system, and increase accountability of juvenile offenders. By placing the money in this fund, the City of Des Moines will be able to access the funds whenever a need is determined.
