CITY COUNCIL ITEM **COMMUNICATION:** OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER 01-374 CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA **SYNOPSIS** -**AGENDA:** The Fire Department has prepared a grant application to the Office of JULY 23, 2001 Justice Programs for the Fiscal Year 2001 Nunn-Lugar-Domenici Domestic Preparedness Equipment Program. The Fire Department is requesting funding to purchase training equipment to be used for SUBJECT: training of "first responders" in a mass casualty incident. **GRANT** APPLICATION TO **FISCAL IMPACT -**OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS FOR The total requested from the Office of Justice Programs is \$280,000. **TRAINING** Other than the salary cost of training on-duty personnel, there is no **EOUIPMENT** other cost to the City. **RECOMMENDATION -TYPE:** Approval. **RESOLUTION ORDINANCE** RECEIVE/FILE **BACKGROUND** -The Office of Justice Programs is providing funds for the purchase of specialized training equipment for fire, emergency medical, and **SUBMITTED BY:** hazardous materials response services as part of the Nunn-Lugar-**RON WAKEHAM** Domenici Domestic Preparedness Program. These funds represent the equipment component of a broader initiative designed to enhance the FIRE CHIEF response capability of designated cities to respond to acts of terrorism involving the use of weapons of mass destruction. The funds are designed to provide "first responders" equipment and training in the event of an explosive, chemical, or biological terrorist act. Direct equipment grant awards are being provided for the procurement of personal protection, detection, and decontamination training equipment. These grants are provided in lieu of the equipment loans that were formerly provided by the Department of

Defense.

The grant award is designed as a "draw down" grant. The City will purchase items previously approved by the Office of Justice Programs. The City will then submit documentation of the purchase and request reimbursement from the Office of Justice Programs. The maximum length of the program is 36 months from the date of federal approval.
