**BACKGROUND -**

The 7th Ward Ditch Flood Control Study, completed in 1996, recommended the wooden box storm sewer serving the 7th Ward Ditch Watershed be replaced to prevent structural failure and improve the capacity. The size of the project and the limited funding available required this project to be built in phases. The first phase of this project, which was constructed in 1999, extended from E. University Avenue to Garfield Avenue. The second phase extends from Garfield Avenue to Cleveland Avenue in the vicinity of E. 29th Street. Future phases are planned to replace the remainder of the wooden box from Garfield Avenue to its beginning at Easton Boulevard. This Supplemental Agreement provides for construction services for the second phase of the 7th Ward Ditch Wooden Box Replacement. Construction observation and testing will be performed by City

construction inspectors. The consultant will provide project management and construction administration.

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
