<b>SUBMITTED BY:</b>	The City maintains a database which establishes the Stormwater Utility charge for each property. This information is supplied to Des Moines Water Works for inclusion in the monthly bill sent to users. The format of the original Storm Water Utility billing system is a customized DBase/DOS application. This application is not consistent with the current software the Information Technology Department supports.
FLOYD BENTZ, P.E. CITY ENGINEER	This supplemental agreement will allow for the reformatting of the database to operate through a Microsoft® SQL7 platform and for GIS functions to comply with the current version of Intergraph Geomedia GIS. Both of these changes were recommended, after considerable interaction among the consultant, the IT department, and the Stormwater Utility staff during the progression of the project

subsequent of the original contract provisions.

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
