WILLIAM MOULDER CHIEF OF POLICE	BACKGROUND -
	The Iowa Department of Commerce has received funds from the tobacco settlement to conduct checks on tobacco retailers for compliance with prohibitions on the sale of tobacco to minors.
	The Vice and Narcotics Control Section of the Police Department will perform the work on an overtime basis. The City has approximately 350 cigarette license permit holders. Random and unannounced compliance checks will be made on these permit holders.
	The City will be reimbursed \$50 for each compliance check. We estimate the cost will be approximately \$35,000.

On January 8, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-129, the City Council approved a similar program for tobacco retailer compliance. This program continues that concept.
