The Council authorized the Mayor and Chief of Police to sign and submit the "Fiscal Year 2000 Federal Annual Certification Report" and the "Fiscal Year 1999 Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Annual Certification Report."
	The report verifies the City's proper use of federal asset forfeiture funds, in accordance with the "Guide to Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeited Property for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies." Equitable sharing of federally forfeited property requires funds to be used for activities calculated to enhance law enforcement. Funds shall not be used to replace or supplant the resources of the law enforcement agency. A complete copy of the "Guide" is on file in the City Clerk's Office.
