	BACKGROUND -
DONALD M. TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	In Fiscal Year (FY) 2000, the City received \$4,500 from this grant source. A grant application was not made for FY2001. This grant award will be applied toward FY2002.
	Nitefall on the River concert series is a ten-week series held at the Simon Estes Riverfront Amphitheater. This is the fifth year of the series, which features a mix of music styles. Nitefall on the River provides quality family entertainment and employs Iowa artists when possible.
	A combination of admission fees, sponsorship dollars, grant dollars, and City funds allow for quality and affordable access to this concert series. The 2001 Concert schedule of ten concerts attracted 22,313 in attendance and was subsidized by \$14,232 in the General Fund Budget.
