DONALD M. TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	The request from the Semi-Pro Baseball League was precipitated by the anticipated completion date of July 20, 2001. Ball Electric, under an existing City contract, was scheduled to complete the work under the bid limit of \$25,000.
	Due to the request of the City to expedite the completion of the field lighting, staff requested Ball Electric work overtime to move the completion date to July 7, 2001. In addition, ballasts and lamps needed to be purchased due to inoperable equipment that was secured from existing softball fields.
	With a base bid of \$22,875 and additional costs for overtime, ballasts, lamp, and a lift rental to reach the light canisters, the total cost for

lighting the field is \$28,643.60. The funds for this improvement will come from the estate gift from George F. and Margaret E. Reiger.
