SYNOPSIS -

SEPTEMBER 10, 2001

Terms of the 2001 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program called for an Advisory Board to be established and for a public hearing to be held to make recommendations on the use of the grant. The Advisory Board held their first meeting on August 2, 2001 to review the grant application. The second meeting and public hearing was held on August 30, 2001 at the Des Moines Police Regional Training Academy. The Advisory Board has prepared and is forwarding their report of non-binding recommendations on the Police Departments proposed use of grant funds.
