DEPUTY CITY MANAGER	On March 20, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-796, the City Council
MANAGER	approved a Contract for Sale of Land for Private Redevelopment
	between the City and Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company, which
	provides for the sale to Nationwide of Parcel C consisting of the block bounded by Locust, Walnut, 12th, and 13th as a part of
	Nationwide's Allied Gateway Campus.
	The City has acquired the properties comprising Parcel C, but is not
	ready to convey the entire parcel. Once all tenants are relocated, the
	City is required to demolish and backfill all basements for
	conveyance to Nationwide. It is anticipated that the tenant in Parcel C (Electrical Engineering and Equipment Company) will be vacated by
	October 2001. The proposed amendment will allow the City to carry

out its obligations under the contract and convey Parcel C when this is accomplished.

Nationwide desires to use the Licensed Area prior to conveyance in order to stage materials and equipment for construction of the office building and structured parking facility contemplated by the Development Agreement. The License Agreement will allow this to occur until such time that 3E vacates the entire parcel and the City is prepared to convey Parcel C to Nationwide.
