	BACKGROUND -
	On August 31, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-3634, the City Council
	approved a Predesign Agreement (Agreement No. 2001-P-028) with
	IDOT for I-235 from the west city limits to the north city limits. IDOT has completed the design of the first sanitary sewer relocation
	project and has taken bids for the work. The project name is the 24th
	Street Sanitary Sewer Relocation, and the work includes the
	relocation of the existing 24-inch trunk sewer that serves homes on

the north side of I-235 to a new location that is not in conflict with the proposed modifications to the I-235 off-ramps and Cottage Grove at Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway.

The 24th Street Sanitary Sewer Relocation Preconstruction Agreement has been negotiated with IDOT to identify the responsibilities of IDOT and the City regarding the administration, funding, and implementation of the project construction. IDOT must approve this document before work may begin.
