CITY COUNCIL ITEM **COMMUNICATION:** OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER 01-512 CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA **SYNOPSIS** -**AGENDA:** The 2002 Iowa Legislature appropriated \$1 million for the Fiscal **OCTOBER 8, 2001** Year 2002 Commercial Air Service Vertical Infrastructure Fund to the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, for **SUBJECT:** improvements at all ten commercial service airports within the state. **GRANT AGREEMENT** WITH IOWA The program provides for one-half of the appropriated funds to be **DEPARTMENT OF** allocated equally between each of the commercial service airports TRANSPORTATION and the remaining 40 percent and 10 percent of the funds are divided based on enplanements and cargo activity, respectively. FOR CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENTS AT** Enplanement data was based on the most current data available THE DES MOINES from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) which is Calendar Year 1999. WILLIAM F. **FLANNERY** AVIATION DIRECTOR BACKGROUND -On June 12, 2001, by Resolution No. A01-64, the Airport Board approved the application to IDOT for the Commercial Air Service Vertical Infrastructure Program for the following projects: · Airfield Maintenance Storage Building · Airfield Maintenance Sand Storage Building

On June 13, 2001, the Aviation Director submitted the application for funding under the Commercial Air Service Infrastructure Program for the project listed above.

On September 18, 2001, IDOT approved and forwarded the proposed grant agreement.

On October 2, 2001, by Resolution No. A01-301, the Airport Board recommended the City Council approve the grant agreement between the City and IDOT.
