<b>SUBMITTED BY:</b>  DONALD M. TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	<b>BACKGROUND -</b>  This 28E Agreement allows both agencies use of each other's facilities for programs and services. In addition, the Des Moines Independent School District provides funds to support the City's Park and Recreation Department's Summer Playground Program and Community Garden Coordinator position.  This Agreement has been revised and renewed annually for over 12 years. The general provisions remain the same as in the past.  This Agreement calls for the shared use of facilities between the school district and the Park and Recreation Department for public recreation programs and for use of office space for Community and Adult Education within the Park and Recreation Administration office.
