	associated with the programs. The Task Force also worked with
	Design Iowa, an initiative of the Iowa Arts Council and their advisors, Bruce Williams, Coordinator of Artists and Public Art
	Programs for the Iowa Arts Council and Jack Becker, Project

Manager for Forecast Public Artworks in St. Paul, Minnesota. On December 18, 2000, the City Council declared its intent to establish a Public Arts Commission and referred the matter to the City Manager for a recommendation on staffing and budget and to the Legal Department for the preparation of the necessary amendments to the Des Moines Municipal Code. The Public Art Task Force Chairs, with technical assistance from the City Legal Department, propose an ordinance to establish a public arts program and a public arts commission.
