	Earlier this year, the City Council authorized execution and submittal
	of federal documents required to access the above-referenced funding
	to implement the City's Brownfields Showcase Initiative. The Cooperative Agreement needs to be signed in order to secure and
	draw down federal funding for this project.

An employee from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region VII, is anticipated to start working directly with the City's Showcase Initiative within the next several months. The assignment is expected to extend from 18 months to two years, depending on available funding.
