<b>SUBJECT:</b>  REVISION TO ORDINANCE REGARDING TEMPORARY FEE ADJUSTMENTS- PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES	<b>FISCAL IMPACT -</b>  The Park and Recreation Department marketing goal is a \$200,000 value in trade of fees and services for media.  <b>RECOMMENDATION -</b>  <b>Approval.</b>  <b>BACKGROUND -</b>
<b>TYPE:</b>  RESOLUTION <u><b>ORDINANCE</b></u> RECEIVE/FILE	State statute established that fees for most Park and Recreation facilities and activities are established by ordinance. On June 20, 1994, the temporary fee adjustment (74-187) was established as a part of the ordinance. The temporary fee adjustment provision is intended for all fees for Park and Recreation facilities. However, the current language limits the temporary fee adjustment to fees in Sections 74-176 through 74-184. The proposed change will include Showmotion fees (Section 74-185), the Amphitheater fees (Section 74-186), and Cemetery fees (Section 34-69). This change will be inclusive so that all fees and charges can be changed for promotional purposes.

TRIPP PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR	The ordinance currently reads: Fees as determined in Sections 74-176 through 74-184 of this article may be changed at the discretion of the Park and Recreation Director upon the approval of the City Manager for engaging in special projects, programs, or promotions that justify such change.  With this change, the ordinance would read: Fees as determined in Sections 74-176 through 74-186, and Section 34-69 of this article may be changed at the discretion of the Park and

Recreation Director upon the approval of the City Manager for engaging in special projects, programs, or promotions that justify such change.
