The Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) has proposed an agreement between the City of Des Moines and IDOT for resurfacing East University Avenue (IA 163) from East 14th Street to East 41st Street, which provides for milling, patching, and full width hot mix asphalt (H.M.A.) resurfacing and traffic median island replacement.

The City will only be responsible for costs of curb replacement and related work on the south side of East University Avenue from East 35th Street to East 41st Street. IDOT has prepared a Project Agreement for the proposed improvements.

FISCAL IMPACT -

The City's obligation for this project is estimated to be \$80,000. Funding for this project is available in the current Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget, with funds transferred from Iowa Air National Guard (IANG) Road Relocation-II. These funds are available since the SW 34th Street Relocation project will be funded 100 percent by the IANG.
