RESOLUTION ORDINANCE RECEIVE/FILE	On August 31, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-3634, the City Council approved a Predesign Agreement (Agreement No. 2001-P-028) with the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for Interstate 235 (I- 235), from the west City limits to the north City limits.

CITY ENGINEER	Professional Service Agreements for the design and property acquisition services with various consultants were approved by the City Council as noted below. The cost associated with the agreements will be attributable to the \$12.7 million cap covered in the Predesign Agreement.
	a. Group 1 Sanitary Sewer Relocations: On July 23, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-2222, the City Council approved the Professional Services Agreement with Howard R. Green Company.
	b. Group 2 Sanitary Sewer Relocations: On July 23, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-2221, the City Council approved the Professional Services Agreement with Stanley Consultants, Inc.

c. Group 3 Sanitary Sewer Relocations: On August 6, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-2376, the City Council approved the Professional Services Agreement with Snyder & Associates.

d. Group 4 Sanitary Sewer Relocations: On August 6, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-2377, the City Council approved the Professional Services Agreement with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc.

There will be normal future City Council action in order to complete these right-of-way acquisitions.
