SALE OF PUBLIC The second mortgage in the amount of approximately \$27,060 is, by program guidelines, held in abeyance for seven (7) years. If the owner HOUSING SINGLE-**FAMILY UNIT** goes the full seven (7) year term, the second mortgage is forgiven. **TYPE: RECOMMENDATION -RESOLUTION** Approval. RECEIVE/FILE **BACKGROUND** -**SUBMITTED BY:** The Department of Housing Services is a participant in the Section 5(h) MICHAEL MATTHES Affordable Homeownership Program which was approved on May 30, **ACTING HOUSING** 2000, by the United States Department of Housing and Urban **SERVICES** Development. Under this program, single-family homes in the public housing inventory are sold to eligible housing program participants. DIRECTOR A housing program participant has made application with Neighborhood Finance Corporation to purchase 122 S.E. Philip. The appraised price of the property is \$82,000. The projected loan amount is \$54,940 with a second mortgage in the amount of \$27,060. The closing of the property is scheduled for November 2001. This application was presented to the Public Housing Board at their

meeting September 19, 2001. The Board recommended that the

Governing Board approve the sale of the property.
