BACKGROUND -

1. In conjunction with the new construction on the southeast corner of East 6th Street and East Locust Street, the Traffic and Transportation Division has modified the existing parking restrictions in this area in coordination with the contractor, Taylor-Ball. The following requested parking restrictions will match the new curb lines and driveway openings and will also insert

appropriate loading zones adjacent to building entrances.

SEC.114-4107. EAST LOCUST STREET--EAST SIXTH STREET TO PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE.

East Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 160 200 feet east of East Sixth Street to a point 115 feet west of East Seventh Street, two-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

SEC.114-4087. EAST SIXTH STREET--EAST WALNUT STREET TO EAST LOCUST STREET.

East Sixth Street, on the east side, from a point 130 feet north of East Locust Street to a point 155 feet north of East Walnut Street, four-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

East Sixth Street, on the east side, from a point 20 feet south of East Locust Street to a point 155 feet north of East Walnut Street, four-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

SEC. 114-2653. EAST SIXTH STREET--EAST WALNUT STREET TO EAST LOCUST STREET.

East Sixth Street, on the east side, from East Locust Street to a point 50 20 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

SEC. 114-3438. EAST LOCUST STREET--EAST SIXTH STREET TO FINKBINE DRIVE.

East Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 110 feet east of East Sixth Street to a point 50 40 feet east thereof, commercial loading zone.

East Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 150 feet east of East Sixth Street to a point 40 50 feet east thereof, commercial loading zone.

2. The Traffic and Transportation Division received a request from a resident regarding turning difficulties due to parked vehicles on East Hackley Avenue at the intersection of SE 5th Street. In order to provide adequate visibility for vehicles at this intersection, staff recommends that 60-foot "corner clearance" no parking zones be established on both sides of East Hackley Avenue east of SE 5th Street. The following revisions to the Municipal Code are necessary to place these changes into effect.

SEC. 114-3287.1. EAST HACKLEY AVENUE--SOUTH UNION STREET TO SOUTHEAST FOURTEENTH STREET.

East Hackley Avenue, on both sides, from Southeast Fifth Street to a point 60 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

3. The Traffic and Transportation Division received a request from a resident regarding turning difficulties due to parked vehicles on Thirty-third Street at the intersection of Forest Avenue. In order to provide adequate visibility for vehicles at this intersection, staff recommends that a 50-foot "corner clearance" no parking zone be established on the west side of 33rd Street north of Forest Avenue. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this change into effect.

SEC.114-2880. THIRTY-THIRD STREET-WOODLAND AVENUE TO AURORA AVENUE.

Thirty-third Street, on the west side, from a point 50 feet south of Forest Avenue to a point 50 feet south thereof north of Forest Avenue, no parking any time.

4. The Traffic and Transportation Division received a request from a resident regarding turning difficulties due to parked vehicles on East Kenyon Avenue at the intersection of South Union Street. In order to provide adequate visibility for vehicles at this intersection, staff recommends that a 60-foot "corner clearance" no parking zone be established on the south side of East Kenyon Avenue east of South Union Street. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this change into effect.

SEC.114-3364. EAST KENYON AVENUE-SOUTH UNION STREET TO SOUTHEAST THIRTY-SECOND STREET.

East Kenyon Avenue, on the south side, from South Union Street to a point 60 feet east thereof, no parking any time.
