FLOYD BENTZ, P.E. CITY ENGINEER	BACKGROUND - Two engineering design services proposals were submitted by Pulley & Associates and Shive-Hattery, Inc. Shive-Hattery, Inc. had a much stronger structural component and provided a more complete representation during construction. Pulley & Associates' structural component was from Cedar Rapids and provided only one site visit. Shive-Hattery, Inc. had done the original study at Fire Station No. 6 with recommendations for a repair at that time. With due consideration, it was determined that the best interest of the project would be served by the selection of Shive-Hattery, Inc. for engineering services on this project.
