	As result of new development and capital improvements in the area of the Hotel Fort Des Moines, the Hotel approached the City regarding streetscape improvements to 10th Street between Mulberry and Walnut Streets and on the south side of Walnut Street along the Hotel's property. The Hotel Fort Des Moines has agreed that 100 percent of all design, administration, construction, and inspection costs assessed against the property to a maximum amount of \$300,000. Funds will be provided from the Special Assessment Account with all future Hotel Fort Des Moines assessments to be credited to the

account for full reimbursement. The account currently has sufficient funds to finance this cost without issuing assessment bonds.

WA Architecture was selected as the consultant for this work as result of discussions with the Hotel Fort Des Moines and WA Architecture. The Hotel Fort Des Moines has approved this selection and the fee for the design.
