	The duties of the Public Art Program Administrator will include:
	· Assisting the Commission in establishing a philosophy for the Public Arts Program.
	· Developing and implementing a written plan that defines the program's vision, goals, objectives, and strategies.
	· Planning and implementing all approved projects within the Fiscal Year (FY) 2003 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget and preparing projects that take place in FY2004.

- · Working in collaboration with the City's communication officer to broadly market and publicize the Public Arts Program and its opportunities for artists and the public.
- · Preparing grant proposals seeking further funding for the Public Arts Program.
- · Informing stakeholders regarding the opportunities available with the Public Arts Program.

On December 18, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-4702, the City Council approved the establishment of an 11 member Public Arts Commission, and referred to the City Manager for staffing and budget and to the Legal Department for the preparation of the necessary amendments to the Des Moines Municipal Code.
