	On November 19, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-3425, City Council authorized the publication and set a public hearing to vacate all of 12th Place between Crocker and School Streets; and to convey by lease a portion of the vacated 12th Place to Mr. Crist.
	Prior to the Council hearing scheduled for December 3, 2001, Mr. Crist determined he no longer wished to lease the property but elected

to purchase the property for the established fair market value of \$158,574.24.

This action will accept the offer to buy and authorize the closing of the real property described as the entire vacated 12th Place between Crocker and School Streets, and close the hearing.
