	July 1998	The City's Major Projects Task Force recognized the need for a new library and the PLDM was included in their recommendation.
	October 10, 2000	The Western Gateway Use and Design Plan was presented to the PLDM board. The theme of the Gateway project is "Lifelong Learning," and the new Central Library was to be a key part of the plan. The PLDM Board voted to accept the plan as presented.

January 22, 2001	The City Council approved the library's Ten- Year Facilities Plan.
