Rock-In-Prevention is requesting the City to sponsor a \$200,000 pass-through grant from the Governor's Office on Drug Control Policy. This grant will enable Rock-In-Prevention to continue a drug prevention program that is currently operating in 15 Des Moines schools.

The program trains high school students to work with elementary age children on drug prevention strategies. The money comes from the Byrne Program through the Department of Justice. The grant is named after a New York City police officer who was killed in a shoot out.

The program is July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003, and requires the City to be the sponsor.
