On March 18, 2002, by Roll Call No. 02-769, the City Council approved the first 15 appointments to the Public Arts Commission.

On March 26, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-848, the City Council approved submittal of a grant application to the Iowa Arts Council Grant Program in the amount of \$25,000.

On December 18, 2000, by Roll Call No. 00-4702, the City Council approved the establishment of an 11 member Public Arts Commission and referred to the City Manager for staffing and budget and to the Legal Department for the preparation of the necessary amendments to the Des Moines Municipal Code.

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
