BACKGROUND -

On March 26, 2001, by Roll Call No. 01-860, the City Council authorized submission of a grant application to the Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance Program for a project by the City of Des Moines and Rock in Prevention to educate children, kindergarten through 12th grade, and families to make happy, healthy drug-free choices. Final approval of the grant was received in June 2001. Operations began July 2001. A contract has been developed that would allow Rock In Prevention to be reimbursed for authorized expenses.
